Function of the Group :

A Special Religious Education Division group has been operating in our Church for some time now. The purpose of SPRED is to enable a group of friends, some with different types of disability, to join together to express their faith and to help them understand the Gospel through activities, stories, reflection and prayer.

SPRED believes that the Church will be all the richer through the inclusion of parishioners with learning difficulties.

The group meets fortnightly to share in art, craft and other simple activities, which quiet the mind and heart to listen to the Word of God around a particular theme later that evening. We end each session by sharing a small friendship meal together.

In the intervening week the volunteers meet to prepare the following week's meeting. Three volunteers from the "core" team – a leader, a parish representative and a volunteer plan the activities. Each of the other volunteers bonds with a "special" friend to enhance a feeling of belonging,

warmth and friendship.

S.P.R.E.D. is not a Prayer Group. It is a faith group meeting to share our experience of God as we have met Him in our lives and the experience of enabling the growth of our faith and belief in God. We volunteers agree that our journey of faith with our S.P.R.E.D. friends constantly develops our own faith and education.

Our S.P.R.E.D. 21+ age group was set in 1987, as agreed with the Parish Priest. S.P.R.E.D. movement also has 5 to 10 years, 11 to 16 years, and 17 to 21 years groups, which are never mixed.

S.P.R.E.D. volunteers are given ample training, so no one should allow a feeling of lack of ability or experience to prevent them from seizing the opportunity to join.
